The Russian Federation has received a loan in the amount of US\$ 460 million equivalent from the New Development Bank to assist in financing the Judicial System Support Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, non-consulting services and consulting services to be procured under this Project.

The purpose of the Project is to enhance judicial efficiency and improve judicial protection of rights and legitimate interests of citizens and organizations by infrastructure development and installation and application of modern information technologies.

The Project consists of the following Components:

COMPONENT 1. Development of Infrastructure of Moscow City Court and District Courts of Moscow:

- 1.1 "Turn-key" construction of district courts, including information and telecommunication infrastructure;
- 1.2 Development of information and telecommunication infrastructure of Moscow City Court and District Courts of Moscow;
- 1.3 Development of the innovative automated system assisting in transition to digital justice and use of artificial intelligence;
- 1.4 Support and upgrade of the current automated information system of courts of general jurisdiction of Moscow city.

COMPONENT 2. Development of the Infrastructure of the Federal Bailiff Service (FBS):

- 2.1 Institutional development to improve the efficiency and openness of the FBS;
- 2.2 Improvement of the FBS software;
- 2.3 Improvement of the FBS hardware infrastructure;
- 2.4 Support of the existing FBS automated information system;
- 2.5 Creating necessary conditions to pursue enforcement proceedings electronically;
- 2.6 Implementation of the mobile automated workplaces of enforcement officers;
- 2.7 Improvement of FBS information security system.

## COMPONENT 3. Project Management:

Provision of support to the Project Implementation Agency through the financing of Operating Costs.

The following items will, inter alia, be procured over a period of five years to implement Components 1 and 2 of the Project: construction of buildings of district courts, information and telecommunication infrastructure and equipment; software, information systems and related consulting services.

Procurement of contracts financed by the New Development Bank will be conducted using the procedures specified in the NDB Procurement Policy (2016, as amended from time to time) and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the NDB Procurement Policy.
