The tender fee given in the table above, which is not refundable, is to be in the form of demand draft or Deposit–at-Call of any schedule commercial bank, payable at Imphal in favour of the Executive Engineer, Water Supply Maintenance Division No-I, PHED, Government of Manipur and should be valid for 90 (ninety) days.
- 6. <u>Bids must be accompanied by scan copies of the Tender Fee and Bid Security</u> (EMD).
- 7. Bids must be submitted online w.e.f 15:00 hours of 27/12/2019 and shall be accepted up to 11:00 Hours of 10/02/2020 and TECHNICAL BIDs will be open

at 14.00 hours of 10/02/2020 & opening of <u>FINANCIAL BIDs (for Technically</u> <u>qualified bidders only</u>) will be notified later. Interested bidders may attend the opening of the bid. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bid as specified, the bid will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

In case, Bid security & Tender Fee are not received within the specified</u> <u>time, the Bid shall be considered non responsive and shall not be</u> <u>downloaded/evaluated.</u>
- 9. Bids shall be strictly treated as non-responsive if:
- i) Bid is not accompanied by an acceptable bid security (with validity for a period of not less than 45 days beyond the validity of bid).
- ii) The undertaking regarding validity of bid, for a period of 90 days after the deadline date for bid submission is not submitted.
- 10. The department shall not be responsible for any delay in postal service or disruption of web service.
- 11. This is an item rate tender. L1 bidder for different pipe sizes will be considered as successful bidder in the tender.
- 12. The rates are inclusive of all taxes, duties, fees, levies and other impositions, levied under the existing, amended or enacted laws during the life of the contract and F.O.R. Imphal for Indian bidder / DDP Imphal for International bidder.
