Project Context	Aracaju is the capital of the state of Sergipe in the northeast region of Brazil. Aracaju's population increased by 45% in the past 20 years and reached around 700 thousand in 2021. The rapid population growth has caused the municipality to face challenges related to inadequate urban infrastructure. This is reflected in the expansion of neighbourhoods to areas without stormwater and sewage system, unpaved and susceptible to floods. It also affects the Aracaju's major mobility corridors with the reduction on the level of service and fast pavement deterioration due to the increase in traffic flow.			
Project Description	The Project consists of the following components: (i) Integrated Sanitation – implementing (i) the stormwater infrastructure in 14 neighborhoods; (ii) sewerage systems totalling approximately 60 km in length; and (iii) four pumping stations and two sewage treatment plants with treated sewage discharge facilities; (ii) Flood Protection – (i) widening and deepening of Médici and Anísio Azevedo canals, (ii) dredging of Poxim river, (iii) building a new canal network to drain the storm water from Expansion Zone, a fast growing area located in the southwest of the city prone to floods; (iii) Urban Mobility – improving the pavement of five avenues of the city (Pres. Tancredo Neves, Visconde de Maracaju, Maranhão, Melício Machado and Náufragos); (iv) Project
