GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

The Government of Bihar (GoB) has applied for a loan of USD 638.12 million, through the Government of India (GoI), to the New Development Bank (NDB), for Bihar Rural Roads Project (Phase-II) involving construction of about 8283 km of rural roads, including cross drainage works & bridges in three phases, to provide good quality all-weathered rural roads for the habitations having 100 + population under Mukhiya Mantri Gram Sampark Yojna (MMGSY) (AWSESH) in the State of Bihar.

The New Development Bank (NDB) intends to provide financing towards the Bihar Rural Roads Project (Phase-II) (BRRP II) implemented by the Rural Works Department through Bihar Rural Roads Development Authority (BRRDA).

The estimated total cost of the proposed project is INR 90.3 billion, which is planned to be financed from the proposed loan from NDB and counterpart fund from the Government of Bihar. The project will require inter alia procurement of the following goods, works and services:

- **Procurement of Consulting Services for Project Management Consultant (PMC);**
- **Procurement of Roads Works in several packages;**
- **Procurement and Development of Project Monitoring System and Asset Management System;**
- **Procurement of Goods for the Establishment of Control and Command Centre;**
- **Procurement of Mobile Ambulance Equipped with Equipment (5 nos.)**

Tendering for the above contract is expected to begin in the Q2 of FY 2023-24 through the Government of Bihar platform <http://www.pmgstendersbih.gov.in>.
