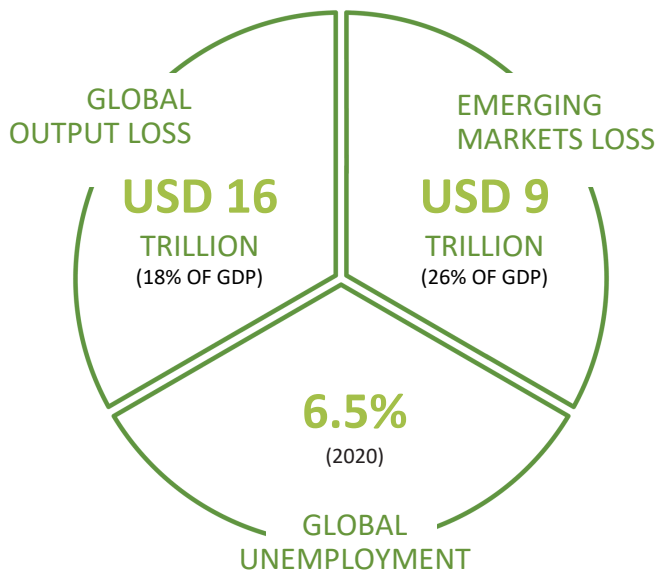

## NDB's Response to COVID-19

Set up **USD 10 billion\*** facility and approved USD 9 billion in loans
