

**MINUTES OF THE PRE-BID MEETING FOR SELECTION OF DESIGN MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION CONSULTANT FOR
“AUGMENTATION OF WATER SUPPLY TO KOHIMA TOWN FROM TEUPUIKI/DZUPFU RIVER” HELD ON 29-05-2026.**

A Pre-Bid Meeting was held on 29th May 2026 at 12:00 Noon in connection with the Request for Proposal (RFP) issued vide No. CE PHE/TB/KMAWS/TEU-DZU/2018-19, dated 18th May 2026, bearing Tender ID: 2026_PHE01_815_1, for engagement of Design Management and Supervision Consultancy (DMSC) Services for the project “Augmentation of Water Supply to Kohima Town from Teupuiki/Dzupfu River.” The meeting was attended by officials of the Public Health Engineering Department (PHED), Government of Nagaland and prospective Consulting firms through both physical attendance and Virtual Conference (VC) mode. The objective of the meeting was to provide clarifications on the provisions of the RFP and to address queries raised by prospective bidders. The queries received during the Pre-Bid Meeting and through subsequent written communications were examined by the Implementing Agency. The clarifications, amendments and modifications issued in response thereto are enclosed herewith and may be taken into consideration while preparing and submitting the proposal.
